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# Timeline of Work Completed



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DPW&T has had the following events take place:

- June 10, 2014 – Berwyn Heights experienced 5.7 inches of rainfall in 90 minutes
  - DPW&T immediately began a task order and started a general study and data collection
- DPW&T completed a recommendation report in September 2017
  - DPW&T presented results to Council on September 17, 2018
- DPW&T's contractor replaced and upgraded inlets during the summer of 2018
  - DPW&T presented to Berwyn Heights on October 16, 2018
- DPW&T completed a full detailed analysis of the drainage systems in March 2021
  - DPW&T presented to Berwyn Heights on April 5, 2021





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# Recommendations



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- The recommendations will be evaluated against all infrastructure Countywide for upgrades.
- Interim Conditions – DPW&T will continue to monitor and respond all PGC311 requests made

What can be done in the interim?

- Report any issues through PGC311
- Urgent needs during storm events can be reported through Dispatch for immediate assistance
