

## Understanding School Bus

 Laws
## When Following or Approaching a School Bus

- Be Prepared to Stop. Flashing yellow lights on the bus are activated 100 to 300 feet prior to the bus stopping to load and unload children.
- Drivers Must Stop and Remain Stopped when the red lights flash. Drivers should not proceed until the flashing red lights are turned off and the bus begins to move.
- Keep mindful of blind spots that exist for buses and students during loading and unloading.


## What is the Law?



TWO LANE Vehicles traveling In both directions MUST STOP.


MULTI-LANE - Paved Across Vehicles traveling in both directions MUST STOP.


DIVIDED HIGHWAY - With dirt, grass or barrier median - Vehicles behind MUST STOP. Vehicles traveling in opposite direction must use caution.

Violations of these Laws: If stopped by an officer the penalty is $\$ 570.00$ and three points on your driving record.
