BERWYN HEIGHTS HOSTS FOUR CITIES COALITION MEETING



Berwyn Heights hosted the quarterly Four Cities Coalition meeting on July 25, 2018. The Four Cities Coalition is a collaboration between municipal leadership from Berwyn Heights, College Park, Greenbelt and New Carrollton that comes together for regular meetings and advocates on common issues impacting our community. Prince George's County Council Chair Danielle Glaros provided a legislative update for participants and encouraged signing up for the "Council Connect" weekly newsletter to stay informed about legislative developments in the county. You may subscribe at https://www.pgccouncil.us/. Rose Simmons from the U.S. Census Bureau also provided an update on the 2020 Census. Stay tuned for more information on that as Berwyn Heights considers what initiatives the town can undertake to ensure an accurate and thorough count of our residents.

Other items for discussion on the agenda included an update on the Urban Land Institute - Technical Assistance Panel project, which is conducting a study of economic development opportunities on Greenbelt Road between Route 1 and Kenilworth Avenue, and possible collaboration between the Education Advisory Committees/Councils of the Four Cities to advocate on behalf of our elementary, middle and high schools. The Coalition also discussed writing a letter to County government leadership expressing support for staffing the Branchville Fire Department with career staff during the daytime hours.
