COUNCIL UPDATE

At the August 8, 2018 Town Meeting, on a 3-1 vote the Council approved a contract worth approximately \$2.2 million dollars to VMP Construction Company of Lanham, Maryland for a renovation project of streets most in need of repair, using both infrastructure reserve funds and a bond issue that was approved by the previous Council. The Council also voted to sign a letter to the Chief of Prince George's County Fire/EMS from the Four Cities Coalition, comprised of elected officials from Berwyn Heights, College Park, Greenbelt and New Carrollton, expressing support for weekday, daytime, career EMT staffing at the Branchville Volunteer Fire Company and Rescue Squad.
