The Commission has three subcommittees: Traffic, Parking, and Street Lighting; Code Enforcement and Rental Housing Issues; and Trash, Beautification and Sidewalks. The Subcommittees are researching issues that have a detrimental impact on the town and recommendations for improvement. 
