CODE COMPLIANCE SPOTLIGHT: PARKING ON UNPAVED SURFACES

The Town recently received constituent complaints regarding individuals parking vehicles on grassy areas in front or back yards. Berwyn Heights Clean Lot Ordinance (Ordinance 107) prohibits parking boats, motorcycles, motor vehicles of any type, trailers or similar items on a residential property except during a snow emergency. All wheels of these vehicles must be parked on an approved paved parking area in order to be in compliance with the ordinance. Paved parking area means any asphalt or other hard rock surface, rolled smooth or level and maintained free of loose materials or excessive vegetative growth. Please make sure to comply with these requirements.

COUNCIL UPDATE

At the July 11 Town Council Meeting, the Council adopted Resolution 1-2018 to amend the Town Charter. The Charter Amendment changes the title of "Town Administrator" to "Town Manager." The Amendment will become effective 50 days after its passage on August 30, 2018, unless a referendum is filed with the Town on or before the 40th day after initial passage of the Resolution.
