Dear Residents,

We need your help keeping our town clean and green! When recycling please do not place plastic bags in your designated containers. Prince George's County's Materials Recycling Facility does not accept plastic bags because they cause machinery malfunctions. We ask that you place only loose recyclable items in your blue bins. *Effective Monday, April 15th, 2019*, failure to comply will result in progressive actions, to include rejection of loads, the issuing of a warnings and finally citations. We encourage you to recycle your plastic bags at local grocery stores and other participating retailers.
