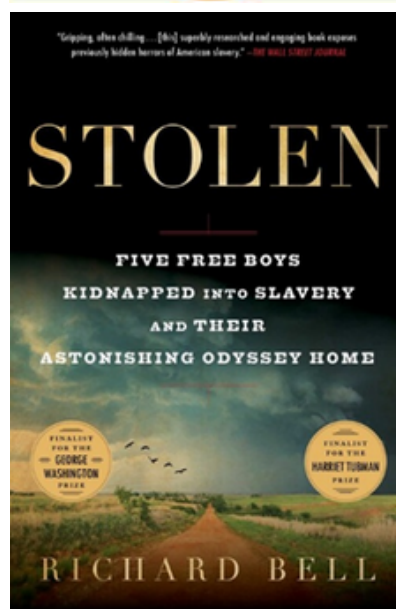

Flood Gates

The Town Council has begun a program to assist residents in obtaining flood gates for their homes. These gates are easy to install to create a secondary barrier on doors that are prone to allowing water into a home. These gates can be locked in place when a storm is pending.

April is Maryland Flood Awareness Month



Know: The first step to reducing the impacts of a flood is knowing your risk. You don't have to live near the water for your home or business to flood. Maryland residents can learn more about their flood risk by searching their address on MD Flood Maps.

Plan: April is a great month to make a plan for flooding. What will you do in case of an emergency? Visit [ready.gov](https://www.ready.gov) for tips on making an emergency plan so you know what you and your family need to do.

Act: Small steps can make a big impact. Consider the following:

- Store important documents off the ground. Save copies of birth certificates, passports, medical records, and insurance papers in a safe, dry place. Keep original documents in a watertight safety deposit box.
- Take photos and videos of household items. Keep them in a safe place if you need to file an insurance claim.
- Call your insurance agent and see if you are covered for flood damage. Most renters and homeowners insurance doesn't cover flooding.
