Curbside Leaf Pickup Continues!

Dec 11-15 North of Pontiac December 18-21: Townwide as time allows

There will be no pick up the week of Dec 25-29. Jan 2-5 Final Townwide pickup.

After January 5, leaves will need to be bagged as yard waste.

Do not mix any other debris with leaves (branches/yard waste/trash). Our vacuum can not pick up them up and the compost facility at College Park doesn't accept any other debris mixed with leaves. **Do not** park cars next to leaf piles. If a car is blocking a leaf pile, it will be skipped until the car is moved and we have time to come back.

Do not place leaf piles in the road. **Do** keep them piled on top of the curb so they don't block storm water


