Effective January 1, 2024, Prince George's County prohibits a retail establishment from providing a plastic carryout bag to shoppers and, with certain exceptions*, must charge and retain at least 10 cents for each paper carryout or reusable bag provided to a customer.

The Town has purchased 100 reusable bags. One per household will be available at Town Hall beginning December 18, while supplies last.

Curbside Leaf Pickup Continues!

Dec 11-15 North of Pontiac

December 18-21: Townwide as time allows

There will be no pick up the week of Dec 25-29.

Jan 2-5 Final Townwide pickup.

After January 5, leaves will need to be bagged as yard waste.

Do not mix any other debris with leaves (branches/yard waste/trash). Our vacuum can not pick up them up and the compost facility at College Park doesn't accept any other debris mixed with leaves. **Do not** park cars next to leaf piles. If a car is blocking a leaf pile, it will be skipped until the car is moved and we have time to come back.

Do not place leaf piles in the road. **Do** keep them piled on top of the curb so they don't block storm water drainage.

Public Works still has a few compost containers available. Both sizes of compost containers are available to residents by request, on a first come/first served basis.
