Black History Month Celebration

The Town of Berwyn Heights hosted the Cornerstone Grand Council of Freemasons event on February 25, 2023. The 50+ people in attendance were informed of the evolution of Black History Month from its beginnings as "Black History Day" in the late 1800s. Three young attendees (Abby, Jacob and Jalin) shared their favorite Black History facts. Ms. Rhonda Miner read the poem "Looking Out for Others" by Alora Knight, and Ms. Dene Sterling danced to the song "Stand Up". The keynote speaker was Colonel Tim Thornton, who provided highlights of the contributions of Black people in the military, from the Buffalo Soldiers and Tuskegee Airmen to General Colin Powell. We thank Mr. Leon Swain for suggesting this event, the Karate Club for sponsoring it and the Cornerstone Grand Council (whose mission is in part to deliver community-based support services for education purposes) for presenting the program. Everyone enjoyed the food, music, opportunity to talk to tablemates and learning about Black History.











Storm Water Fair
