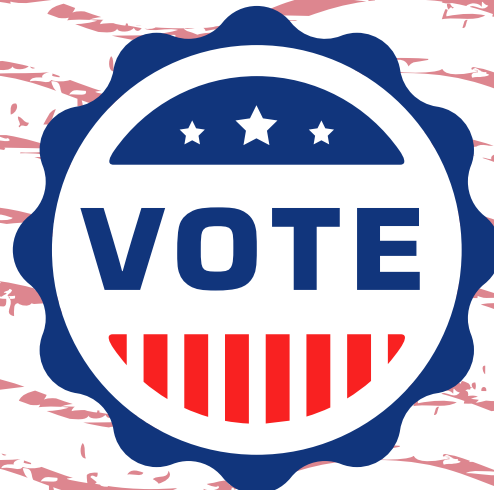

Emergency Skills Classes

Neighborhood Watch/Emergency Preparedness is sponsoring two very important classes to help equip the community with skills that can save a life.

During the regularly scheduled meeting on February 7th, the Prince George's County Health Department will be holding a training program for residents on the use of Naloxone (a drug that reverses opioid overdose symptoms) and educating residents on Fentanyl, Xylazine, and all related opioids.

Register by February 1st to receive a Narcan kit on completion of the training.

CPR/AED and First Aid training will take place on Saturday, February 24th from 1-4PM in the Town Center (2nd Floor). This life-saving class will cover topics such as Cardio-Plumonary Resuscitation (CPR), use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED), choking response, and bleeding and wound care.

Advance registration is required and all who register by February 22nd will be awarded CPR certification upon completion of the class.

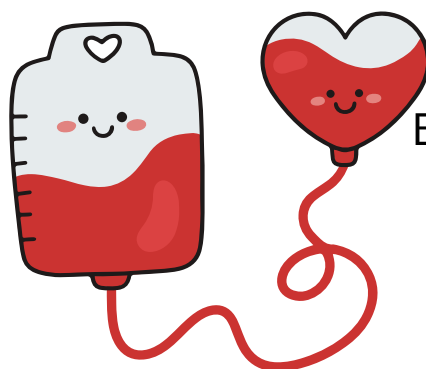
