Amount of Snow	Time to Make Roads Passable	Time to Fully Clear Roads
< 4 inches	4-6 hours	1 day
4-6 inches	6-8 hours	2-3 days
> 6 inches	8+ hours	3-5 days

Safety First: Virtual Learning for Students Through Jan. 14

Amid a rise in COVID-19 cases in schools and new quarantine guidance from the Prince George's County Health Department, CEO Dr. Monica Goldson announced a temporary shift to virtual learning for all students. In-person learning will resume Tuesday, Jan.18, following the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. holiday.

For this week, breakfast and lunch will be available for pick up at 20 school sites from 11 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on January 5; for 2 days of breakfast and lunch on Thursday, January 6 from 10 a.m. to noon. The list of schools is available <u>online</u> and it appears that Riverdale Elementary may be the closest location to Berwyn Heights.
