## Storm Recovery



## A tree fell in my yard. What do I do?

Please contact your homeowner's insurance. Your homeowner's insurance may have preferred providers for storm damage. If the tree is on private property (not in the Town's right of way), the tree is your responsibility to address. If the tree is in the right of way, your insurer will contact the Town to access liability. For large trees, please work with a tree crew to remove the debris from you yard as the Town does not have the capabilities to pick up large tree trunks. Contractors should be willing to haul waste away.
