## Curbside Leaf Pickup

Curbside Leaf Collection has begun. The anticipated schedule, weather permitting is:

Nov. 13-17 North of Pontiac

Nov 20-22 South of Pontiac

Nov 27-Dec 1 North of Pontiac

Dec 4-8 South of Pontiac

Dec 11-15 North of Pontiac

**Do not** mix any other debris with leaves (branches/yard waste/trash). Our vacuum can not pick up them up and the compost facility at College Park doesn't accept any other debris mixed with leaves. **Do not** park cars next to leaf piles. If a car is blocking a leaf pile, it will be skipped until the car is moved and we have time to come back. **Do not** place leaf piles in the road. **Do** keep them piled on top of the curb so they don't block storm water drainage.



# Curbside Composting Pilot Container Program!

Public Works has received two sizes of compost containers that are available to residents by request, on a first come/first served basis.

- All food items such as vegetables, breads and starches, meat and bones.
- Compostable or biodegradable bags, food containers and dinnerware.
- Coffee filters, hair and nail clippings, grease free paper towels and napkins, toothpicks, etc.
