Election Day is November 8, 2022. Residents of Berwyn Heights can vote in-person on Election Day at Berwyn Heights Elementary School from 7am to 8pm.

Same Day voter registration is available during Early Voting and on Election Day. For same day voter registration, bring documentation to prove where you live (examples: include: MVA issued license, ID card, change of address card, paycheck, bank statement, or utility bill)

The Town Council has set aside funds from the ARPA programing to provide relief to residents experiencing financial hardships due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

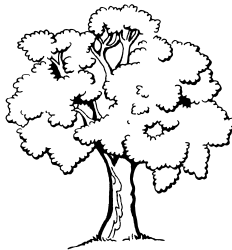
Many residents may be eligible without realizing it and could receive a maximum of \$3,000 toward eligible expenses.
