COMPOSTING UPDATE!

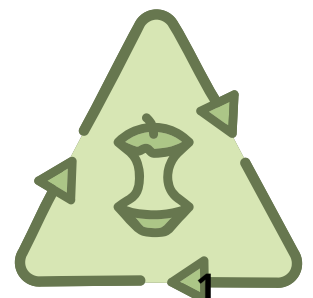
Beginning October 24th there is a new composting pilot program. Compost may be co-mingled with yard waste for Public Works to pick up. The bins behind Town Hall will be phased out. Please place **food scraps** in one of the following:

- Compostable Green Bags
- Co-mingled in brown paper yard waste bags (if dry and sanitary)
- 5 Gallon Bucket

Items accepted by the compost facility are

- All food items including vegetables, bread, meat and bones
- Compostable and biodegradable bags

ARPA RESIDENTIAL RELIEF

The Town Council has set aside funds from the ARPA programing to provide relief to residents experiencing financial hardships due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
