Indigenous Peoples' Day: A Brief History

- In 1934 as result lobbying by the Knights of Columbus, Franklin D. Roosevelt proclaimed October 12 Columbus Day
- Legislation to establish Columbus Day as a National Holiday was signed by Lyndon B. Johnson in 1968, with the first observation in 1971
- In 1990 the International Conference on
 Discrimination Against Indigenous Populations in
 the Americas, sponsored by the UN, began the
 discussion to replace Columbus Day with
 Indigenous Peoples' Day. South Dakota was the
 first state to change the name of the holiday.
- In 1992 the City Council of Berkeley, CA declared October 12 "A Day of Solidarity with Indigenous People"
- Since 1992, other local governments have followed Berkeley's lead, either renaming or canceling Columbus Day
- At least 12 States and Washington DC do not celebrate Columbus Day.


