



ARPA RESIDENTIAL RELIEF


The Town Council has set aside funds from the ARPA programing to provide relief to residents experiencing financial hardships due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Many residents may be eligible without realizing it and could receive a maximum of \$3,000 toward eligible expenses.

We've enhanced our financial assistance programs to help even more customers.

Our Customer Service Advisors are here to help and ready to work with you to determine a convenient payment option.

Bill adjustments are available to residential customers once every three years under certain circumstances.

Flexible payment options including extended due dates and convenient payment plans. Late fees waived for customers successfully completing their payment plans.


CAP-approved customers may be eligible for a payment plan up to 48 months. Late fees permanently waived for CAP customers.

All other customers may be eligible for a payment plan up to 36 months.



Need help repairing your water service line?
PipeER
Provides a loan to finance the replacement of a residential water service line. Qualified customers are eligible to receive a loan up to \$5,000. PipeER is administered by the WSSC Federal Credit Union.

Need long-term financial assistance?
Your income might make you eligible for one of three programs that can reduce your WSSC Water bills in the future.

The Water Fund allows for multiple requests for assistance with water and sewer bills, up to \$500 per year. The program is administered by The Salvation Army and funded by generous donations from WSSC Water customers, employees and community partners, wsscwater.com/waterfund.





NATIVE PLANTING FOR FALL

Warm soil, sufficient rain, and cool weather help make for the best root growth conditions. Fall is the best time to plant trees and prepare your garden for successful winter, or even spring, sprouts.

- Cut back herbaceous (non-woody stem) perennials.
- Plant spring-blooming bulbs now like tulips, daffodils, or hyacinths.
- Clean and cover vegetable gardens or flower beds if you aren't planting winter vegetables.
- Plant native trees that support pollinators, birds, and wildlife, such as red oak, tulip poplar or redbud.



To help customers plan and prepare for an emergency, Pepco offers the following tips:

- **Stay connected**

Getting up-to-date information has never been easier. To stay in the know about your outage status, estimated restoration times, and more, download the Pepco app on iOS or Android devices. To stay even more connected, sign up for text alerts. Text “Add Outage” to 48710 to get started.

- **Update your info**

Visit our [website](#) to ensure we have your most current contact information in “My Alerts & Notifications.” This is helpful in the event we need to reach you during an emergency.

- **Assemble an emergency kit**

No need to wait for the first sign of trouble. You can act now to prepare for a storm. Pack an emergency prep bag with flashlights, fresh batteries, medication, water, and non-perishable foods to last you at least 72 hours.

- **Know how to report an outage**

- **Electric safety information**

Always assume any downed wire is energized and stay away. To report downed wires, please call 1-877-PEPCO62.
